

2018 Traditional Bank GoodGiving Challenge Scavenger Hunt Official Rules

1. No donation is required to participate in the scavenger hunt.
2. All participants must abide by all applicable traffic laws.
3. Blue Grass Community Foundation is not responsible for any accidents or injuries involving participants in the scavenger hunt.
4. Participants are required to take a photograph of themselves (i.e., a selfie) in front of six different nonprofit organizations. The organizations may be identified using clues which describe them in the 2018 GoodGiving Guide.
5. To be eligible for the prize, participants must:
 - a. Take the selfies in front of the organizations at the physical address listed in the GoodGiving Guide. Photos taken at locations other than the addresses listed in the GoodGiving Guide will result in disqualification.
 - b. Take a photo which includes the physical location of the nonprofit AND signage of the organization.
 - c. Appear in all six of the selfies.
6. The first participant to report to the office of Blue Grass Community Foundation and present photos of himself/herself in front of all six nonprofit organizations will win a \$5,000 prize, which must be redeemed through the GoodGiving Challenge to any of the participating nonprofits, but no more than five, in \$1,000 increments.
7. Only one participant is allowed per photo. If multiple individuals appear in the photos, it will count as an entry for only one of those participants, not all of them.
8. Consolation prizes may also be awarded to other scavenger hunt participants who do not finish first.
9. In the event of a tie (two finishers arriving at Blue Grass Community Foundation at EXACTLY the same time), the prize will be split evenly between the two participants.
10. BGCF staff and their families are ineligible to play.
